Resolution of Intent to Reoccupy Vacated Space Due to Short-Term
Special Housing Burden

Resolution No. 16-09

A Resolution of the Board of Directors certifying instructional use of a school facility or building for the purpose of alleviating a short-term special school housing burden that was previously replaced using School Construction Assistance Program funds.

WHEREAS, the District owns the upstairs of CHOICE High School, which has been vacated for instructional purposes since being replaced with the new facility using School Construction Assistance Program funds in 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has previously resolved that the upstairs of CHOICE High School would no longer be used for instructional purposes per WAC 392-347-042 and be ineligible for any future financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Shelton School District has identified a district-wide short-term housing burden due to enrollment growth and the failure to raise school construction bonds (capital levies) since 2001; and







WHEREAS, Substitute House Bill 2985 provides an allowance to reoccupy such vacated schools without penalty from July 1, 2016 until June 30, 2021 for the purposes of alleviating a short-term housing burden; and

WHEREAS, the Shelton School District has consulted with and has received approval from the Superintendent of Public Instruction to reoccupy the upstairs of CHOICE High School under the conditions set forth by SHB 2985;


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Shelton School District shall reoccupy the upstairs of CHOICE High School for instructional purposes under the conditions of SHB 2985 until June 30, 2021.
